## The following positions are available through Army Youth Programs in Your Neighborhood (AYPN) funding

**Security Staff** – Seeking an individual with a background in security, committed to positive and consistent interactions with high school youth beginning mid January through the end of the school year. This position will involve patrol of the WHS and WCC campuses 3:00 p.m. – 7:15 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 2:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. on Friday. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$15.00 per hour**

**After School Program Club Leader** – Under the direction of the Site Coordinator, will provide assistance and tutoring to students in the after school program. Will lead engaging academic, enrichment and recreation activities with groups of up to 20 students providing opportunities for students to develop and strengthen academic, physical and social skills. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$10.00 per hour**

**After School Program Recreation Club Leader** – Under the direction of the Site Coordinator, will work as a member of a team to implement recreation activities, e.g. organized games/physical activities, dance, martial arts, sports, with groups of up to 20 students. Will provide opportunities for students to do well and find enjoyment in recreation activities, develop and strengthen recreation and social skills and support school day success. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$10.00 per hour**

**After School Program Literacy Specialist Club Leader** – Under the direction of the Site Coordinator, will work as a member of a team to implement engaging literacy activities, e.g. spoken word, reading groups, creative writing, drama club, etc. with groups of up to 20 students. Will provide opportunities for students to do well and find enjoyment in literacy projects, develop and strengthen literacy and social skills and support school day success. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$10.00 per hour**

**After School Program Data Library Monitor** – Works as a member of the after school and library team to provide a positive, enriching after school library experience for students. The Library Monitor has primary responsibility for assuring that all library procedures are followed. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$10.00 per hour; Certificated School Librarians: 10 hours per week at \$25.50 per hour**

**After School Program Data Management Specialist** – Under the general direction of the After School Program Director, will work with the Student Information Systems Analyst/Operator to organize, verify and process student information forms. Will enter data and produce reports in printed format, provide technical information and current data to supervisors and office staff, performs other record-keeping and clerical duties. **Compensation: 40 hours per week at \$10.00 per hour**

**After School Alternative Program Assistant** – Under the direction of the Site Coordinator, will work as a member of a team to support high school students enrolled in an evening alternative program with program completion requirements. Position will support the emotional and affective components of student needs. Required background in the areas of education, youth development, counseling, social work, juvenile justice or comparable fields. **Compensation: 20 hours per week at \$15.50 per hour**
