Physical Facilities and Technical Infrastructure Plan

Technical Infrastructure: The technical infrastructure is maintained by the Waynesville R-VI School District. The district's Technology Department, in collaboration with K12ITC (3rd party vendor), provides a safe and secure network for students to utilize for their educational needs. All the networks are made safe and secure and are continuously updated to ensure that students' educational and privacy needs are met.

Physical Facilities: The Waynesville Career Center follows the Waynesville R-VI School Districts Facility and Maintenance Plan. This plan is developed with the support of the Districts CSIP Plan, Strategic Focus Area: Facilities/Resources. This document serves as a framework for the vision of the Waynesville R-VI School District facilities. This facilities plan will serve as the basis of information for reference during subsequent phases.

The School Superintendent will initiate the facilities planning and will consider suggestions from the administration and staff. Any suggestions will be presented to the Board of Education through the Superintendent before approval of the facilities plan. These plans will include recommendations based on activities that will take place in the building to include the following:

- Specific architectural characteristics desired
- Equipment and supplies required
- Spatial relationship to other district facilities
- Other pertinent factors.

Any new construction or major renovations will be designed in accordance with seismic design standards if required by law, and will comply with access requirements for persons with disabilities as required by law, as well as any applicable state and federal laws, codes, and regulations

The District may acquire real property necessary for facility improvement or expansion through eminent domain only in accordance with the law. The district will provide for the relocation of any persons displaced by the acquisition of property through eminent domain as required by and in accordance with law.
