

# Discipline Statement

## Student Discipline for Enrollment:

Prior to admission, the Waynesville R-VI Board of Education requires any parent, guardian, or person having control or charge of a child of school age to provide, upon enrollment, a sworn statement of affirmation indicating whether the student has been expelled or suspended from school attendance at any school in this state or in any other state for an offense in violation of school board policies relating to weapons, alcohol, drugs, or for the willful infliction of injury to another person. **Any person making a materially false statement of affirmation may be guilty upon conviction of a class “B” misdemeanor and nullifies the enrollment process.**

In accordance with the Missouri Safe Schools Act, the following information is required for all new students enrolling or being readmitted:

## Admission Restriction

No student may be readmitted or enrolled in the Waynesville R-VI School District who has been convicted of or charged with an act which, if committed by an adult, would be one of the following: *first or second degree murder, kidnapping when classified a class “A” felony, first or second degree assault, forcible rape, forcible sodomy, burglary in the first or second degree, robbery in the first degree, distribution of drugs, arson in the first degree, voluntary or involuntary manslaughter, sexual assault, felonious restraint, property damage in the first degree, possession of a weapon, child molestation in the first degree, deviate sexual assault, sexual misconduct involving a child, and sexual abuse.* Students may be readmitted or enrolled if the charge has been dismissed or when the student has been acquitted.
