

ACTIVITIES & ATHLETICS TRANSPORTATION POLICY

If parents/guardians provide transportation to or from, or allow another adult or their son/daughter to provide transportation to or from scheduled interscholastic athletic events, including practices, they must be aware that the following policies are in effect:

- Where a parent/guardian transports their son/daughter to or from a scheduled event, including practices, the parent/guardian shall assume all resulting liability, and the school shall assume no liability.
- Where a parent/guardian, or another adult designated by a parent/guardian transports students other than their own to or from a scheduled event, including practices, the parent/guardian or designated adult transporting the students shall assume all resulting liability, and the school shall assume no liability.
- Where a student transports himself/herself to or from a scheduled event, including practices, the parents/guardians of that student shall assume all resulting liability, and the school shall assume no liability.
- Where a student transports other students to or from a scheduled event, including practices, the parents/guardians of the transporting student shall assume all resulting liability, and the school shall assume no liability.
- If a student engages in any form of transportation described above without a signed Transportation Liability Waiver on file, the Waynesville R-VI School District assumes no responsibility or liability and in addition the student will receive consequences for not following the above-mentioned policy.

TRANSPORTATION LIABILITY WAIVER REQUEST FORM

I have read the Activities & Athletics Transportation Policy and agree that I shall assume all liability for injuries resulting from the following situations:

- Where I transport my son/daughter to or from a scheduled event;
- Where I transport other students to or from a scheduled event;
- Where I, as a parent/guardian, give permission to another adult to transport my son/daughter home from a scheduled event;
- Where my son/daughter transports himself/herself to or from a scheduled event; or
- Where my son/daughter transports other students to or from a practice or scheduled event.

I also agree that the Waynesville R-VI school district and staff shall assume no liability whatsoever for injuries resulting from the above situations or any other situation where district-provided or district-contracted transportation is not being used to transport athletes.

Prior to participating in any practice or tryout session for any interscholastic activity, each student must successfully pass a physical examination by a registered physician and a copy of such examination must be on file in the office of the building athletic administrator. A physical exam is valid if issued on or after February 1 of the previous school year. Prior to participating in any MSHSAA and/or Waynesville R-VI School District sponsored event each student athlete must have on file in the office of the building athletic administrator the Athletic Commitment Form with parent and student signatures.

As a student-athlete participating voluntarily in interscholastic activities,

1. I have read the MSHSAA Activity Handbook and understand what MSHSAA and the Waynesville R-VI School District expects from me in regards to sportsmanship, citizenship, scholastics, and staying free from tobacco, alcohol, and illegal drug use while enrolled in this school. I understand the consequences for breaking MSHSAA and/or school policy and I will not do so while a Waynesville R-VI School district student participant. I understand that this is a year-round (365 day) commitment.
2. I will be responsible for all school equipment issued to me throughout the season, will return such equipment at the conclusion of the season, and will pay the current replacement cost for any of the equipment not accounted for by me at the end of the season.
3. I acknowledge that I have been properly advised, cautioned and warned by administrative and coaching personnel of the school district that I am exposing myself to the risk of injury, including but not limited to the risk of sprains, fractures and ligament and/or cartilage damage which could result in a temporary or permanent, partial or complete impairment in the use of my limbs, brain damage, paralysis, or even death. In addition, I understand that there is a higher-potential to contact disease, viruses, and infections, while participating in athletics and activities. Having been so cautioned and warned, it is still my desire to participate in sports and to do so with full knowledge and understanding of the risk of injury.
4. I, along with my parents, certify that we have read and understand all of the school district activity policies in the Activity Handbook and MSHSAA eligibility standards. In order to be eligible for participation, I understand I must comply with all requirements listed.
5. In addition, I understand that Waynesville School District has a No-F policy for participation – I must pass all courses the previous semester in order to be eligible for grades 9-12; grades 7th/8th eligibility is determined using 9-week grading periods.
