Summer School

A tuition-free Summer School program will be available for students who will be **entering kindergarten through fifth grade** this fall in the Waynesville R-VI School District. For the purpose of Summer School, students attend the grade they will enter this fall. If your child would like to attend Summer School, please complete the registration form and return it to your child's school by **April 14th**. Late registrations will be accepted on a space available basis after April 14th. A separate registration form will be sent for students who will be in sixth grade next year, as they will attend the Sixth Grade Center Summer School program

Students attending kindergarten in the fall must be 5 years old on or before July 31, 2023. To register your child for the kindergarten summer school program, you can turn this form in at Williams Early Childhood or you can turn in the form at the building your child will attend in the fall. A birth certificate and current shot record will be required for students who are not currently enrolled in the district. Students who are entering kindergarten in the fall will also receive their kindergarten teacher assignment at the conclusion of summer school.

Programming-

Summer school will be held from 7:40 a.m. to 2:10 p.m. June 1st-June 29th. Please note that there will be no school on Monday, June 19th in observation of the Juneteenth holiday. Summer school will be offered at East, Freedom, Partridge, Thayer and Wood.

Our on-site summer school program at the Waynesville Elementary Schools will focus on three areas. The first area will be for those students who need to improve their reading, writing and math skills. The second area will be for students who are on grade level and want to improve their grades for the next school year by expanding their learning. The third area will be for students who are above grade level in reading, writing and math and would like to explore new concepts.

Children should arrive at school after 7:25 a.m.; supervision is very limited before school. Perfect attendance is encouraged; however, if your child needs to be absent, please notify the office in advance. Students missing more than three days of school will be dropped unless the school is informed of the absence.

Breakfast and lunch will be served at each summer school location during summer school, June 1st-June 29th.

Limited bus routes and stops will be provided. Students in kindergarten through 12th grades may be consolidated on the same buses during Summer School. For students who ride the bus, transportation will only be provided to the student's regularly assigned home school. If a site other than the regularly assigned school is selected, then transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Cutting EDGE STEM Academy

We are excited to announce the Summer 2023 Cutting EDGE STEM Academy. The STEM Academy is open to students who will be in grades 3,4 and 5 this fall. The Academy will operate during our regular summer school dates and times. We will have at least one classroom at each of our 5 elementary summer school sites- East, Freedom, Thayer, Partridge and Wood.

We will begin accepting registration applications at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 9th. Registrations will be accepted in the order they are received. The registration link will close at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 6th. You will be notified regarding your child's placement in the program in May.

NOTE: You will also need to complete a paper summer school form in addition to the online STEM Academy Registration.

There is something for every student entering kindergarten through fifth grade in the Club TIGER Afterschool Program. Students enjoy spending time with friends while participating in a variety of interactive hands-on activities including enrichment projects, fitness fun, field trips, crafts and much more. Club Tiger is only available to students who attend the on-site summer school program.

When: Every day after Summer School (June 1-June 29) until 6:00 p.m. **No transportation home is provided.**

Locations:

- 1- East Elementary in Waynesville (Open to East Elementary students, including those entering kindergarten.)
- 2- Freedom Elementary in St. Robert (Open to Waynesville R-VI elementary students, including those entering kindergarten, attending Freedom, Partridge, Thayer, or Wood Elementary schools. Bus transportation will be provided from your school to Freedom Elementary for Club TIGER.)

Fee: There is an enrollment fee of \$30 for new students. The weekly fee is based on lunch status: Full lunch, \$50 per week; reduced lunch, \$40 per week; and free lunch, \$30 per week.
