Join us at the Sixth Grade Center as our students experience a universe of wonders. Our summer school program is intended to support the whole child in the development of their physical, social-emotional, and intellectual growth while establishing the foundation for lifelong learning. Curriculum will be integrated with the purpose of learning through problem based projects, learning centers, and activities. Students will have an opportunity to acclimate to the Sixth Grade Center building and procedures during the summer learning experience.

For the purpose of summer school, students attend the grade they will enter this fall. If your child would like to attend Summer School, please complete the registration form and return it to your child's current building where he/she is attending 5th grade or to the Sixth Grade Center by April 14th. Late registration will be on a space available basis after April 14th.

Please note that Summer School will not be in session on Monday, June 19th, in observance of the Juneteenth holiday.

### **Summer School Programming**

Our on-site summer school program will focus on three areas. The first area will be for those students who need to improve their reading, writing and math skills. The second area will be for students who are on grade level and want to improve their grades for the next school year by expanding their learning. The third area will be for students who are above grade level in reading, writing and math and would like to explore new materials. Students will also participate in transition activities.

#### Attendance & Behavior

Summer school will be held from 7:25 a.m. to 1:55 p.m. June 3-June 30. Children should arrive at school after 7:10 a.m.; supervision is very limited before school. Perfect attendance is encouraged; however, if your child needs to be absent, please notify the office in advance.

If a student gets three referrals to the office for their behavior they will be dismissed from summer school.

#### Breakfast & Lunch

Breakfast and free lunch will be served at Waynesville Sixth Grade Center during Summer School, June 1-June 29.

#### **Bus Transportation**

Limited bus routes and stops will be provided and students in kindergarten through 12th grades may be consolidated on the same buses during Summer School.

#### Summer Club TIGER After School Program

There is something for every student entering 6th, 7th and 8th grades in the Club TIGER After School Program. Students enjoy spending time with friends while participating in a variety of interactive hands-on activities including enrichment projects, fitness fun, field trips, crafts and much more.

Transportation: A limited evening activity bus route will be available for Club TIGER participants.

Fee: The monthly fee is based on lunch status: Full lunch, \$50 per month; reduced lunch, \$40 per month; and free lunch, \$30 per month.
