

## Advanced Placement Courses

Advanced Placement courses give high school students the opportunity to get a head start on college-level work. Students that are enrolled in AP courses may choose to take the AP Exam at the end of the year to potentially receive college credit for that course. College credit is earned based on student scores on the AP Exam. Students are encouraged to contact their future college or university to determine the AP credit policy for their school. Each AP course offered is approved by the College Board. These courses are subject to teacher availability.
