**In order to be eligible to access school virtually through MOCAP the following requirements are in place:**

- 1- Students wishing to enroll in full-time virtual programming through MOCAP must be enrolled as a student in the Waynesville R-VI school district. Students who are not currently enrolled with the District will need to complete the District enrollment process prior to submitting MOCAP Full-Time Virtual Learning Intent to Enroll Form.
  - a. Once the student’s enrollment with the MOCAP provider has been finalized with the MOCAP provider, the student will be withdrawn from the Waynesville R-VI School District.
  - b. Parents are responsible for notifying the District if the student moves out of the district. If the student enrolls in another Missouri district the student is eligible to remain in the virtual program through the new district. If the student moves out of the state of Missouri, the student will be dropped from the virtual program or the student may continue at parent expense.
- 2- Students who enroll full-time through MOCAP are not eligible to participate in District athletics, activities or clubs.
- 3- The resident district does not supply computers, internet, or mobile devices for students to access MOCAP courses.
