Please complete the below information if your child does not meet the Missouri kindergarten & first grade entry requirements, but you are active military & your child has attended and completed an accredited pre-k or kindergarten program in another state.

- *Per Section 160.053, RSMo a child is eligible for admission to kindergarten if the child reaches the age of five and is eligible for admission to first grade if the child reaches the age of six before the first day of August of the school year beginning in that calendar year. A child is eligible for admission to kindergarten/first grade if the child is a military dependent and has successfully completed an accredited pre-kindergarten program or has attended an accredited kindergarten program in another state.*

Entrance Age

In accordance with law, a student is eligible for admission to attend the Waynesville R-VI School District, and is eligible for admission to summer school the summer prior to entering kindergarten, if the student:

1. Reaches the age of five before August 1 of the school year in which he or she plans to enroll.
2. Has attended school, or the summer school prior to a kindergarten school term, in the St. Louis City School District or the Kansas City 33 School District, regardless of the age of the student.
3. Is a child in the household of an active duty member of the military, including some veterans who are deceased or injured as defined by law, who has successfully completed an accredited pre-kindergarten program or has attended an accredited kindergarten in another state, regardless of the age of the student.

Students who are entering kindergarten or first grade are encouraged to preregister in the spring prior to the fall semester in which they are to begin attendance. Students entering the schools in the district will be required to present a birth certificate or other acceptable proof of age if necessary to determine whether the student is eligible to attend school.
