

The Waynesville Tech Intern (WTI) class is a hands-on study of technology integration, problem solving and Chromebook repair. Students will be required to assess problems and define the best approach to addressing or solving the problem. In addition, WTI students will choose a Pathway Project in a technology field.

- Students will learn how to repair Chromebooks utilized in Project Edge 1:1 Plan. Repairs include monitor replacement, key replacement and replacement of internal parts.
- WTI students will learn how to troubleshoot student and teacher problems related to the Chromebook and other network/software issues.
- WTI students will also have the opportunity to pursue an individual
 WTI Pathway Project. Students get to decide what pathway to pursue.
